Recommended Practice Experience

The Laboratory Medical Direction Advanced Practical Pathology Program (LMD AP³) is designed for pathologists who are currently in an LMD or section head role and have overall responsibility for all operations of the laboratory including: general leadership, personnel management, budgeting, quality, accreditation, and risk management. To maximize your learning experience, the CAP recommends, but does not require, that you have at least 3 years experience in either of these roles.

Education Requirements

The purpose of LMD AP³ is to facilitate effective performance in the key, strategic knowledge and skill areas that these roles require. The LMD AP³ curriculum includes 30 hours of CAP-sponsored CME including self-paced, online learning and self-assessment modules (SAMs) and a live, faculty-led workshop. Please refer to the LMD AP³ program manual for specific details regarding the education program. A cognitive assessment will be administered after completion of the CME/SAM components. In addition, you will complete a practical assessment by which you will demonstrate your knowledge and skills.
