Recommended Practice Experience

The Multidisciplinary Breast Pathology Advanced Learning Series is designed for practicing anatomic pathologists that have experience in neoplastic and non-neoplastic breast disease. The CAP recommends that participants have work experience regularly diagnosing or reviewing benign and malignant breast specimens. This includes any case reviewed in intradepartmental and extradepartmental consultation, and all cases presented at a multidisciplinary breast conference, tumor board or imaging/pathology correlation conference attended by pathologists.

Education Requirements

The purpose of the MBP is to identify the holder as one who not only devotes a significant part of his or her medical practice to breast disease, but who has also committed the time to demonstrate the skills necessary to be an essential part of a multidisciplinary patient care team. The MBP curriculum includes an estimated 30.25 hours of CAP-sponsored CME consisting of self-paced, online learning and self-assessment modules (SAMs) and live, faculty-led courses.
